The unique signature of Solutionary Insights is the intertwining of respect and value of individuals, the belief that all are capable of excellence, the advantages of learning by solving problems, and the resolve that fine and purposeful teaching and parenting develop outstanding abilities.



**Blancamaría Montecinos Valdivia's** academic background and studies include voice training, Kodály Method, Dalcroze, Jazz and Instrumental Piano, complemented with research in psychology to understand and nurture her work. Her studies of Musical Pedagogy favour her approach towards group dynamics, used in the Suzuki Method. Former president of the Suzuki Association of Chile (1995- 2005), in 2001 she was the creator of Escuela de Música Suzuki Chile, which is currently one of the most recognized Suzuki Schools in Chile with more than 200 students ages 0 to 80. Escuela de Música Suzuki has been relevant in the Chilean Suzuki teacher training world, inviting teacher trainers to do "core" courses specifically focusing on the importance of early books, Filosofía and Teaching Strategies. In May of 2019, Ms. Valdivia received her Teacher Trainer status from the Suzuki Association of the Americas.
